



COVID-19 Survey Results: Peoria Adult Transition Center

The John Howard Association (JHA) is an independent citizen correctional oversight organization that goes into prisons to monitor conditions of confinement and treatment of people who are incarcerated; we fight for a fair and humane system and for government transparency and accountability. For 119 years we have been the eyes and ears of the public inside Illinoisqprisons, reporting what we see, hear and learn inside facilities and using this information to recommend policy and practice changes and advocate for system reform.

It is critical that we know and understand how people in prison are experiencing the COVID-19 health crisis and what the government must do to meet the health needs of people in prison. To further this end, JHA launched a special system-wide COVID-19 survey to enable us to hear directly from those who are in prisons about prison conditions during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The survey results reported herein indicate how 16 people imprisoned at Peoria Adult Transition Center (ATC) responded to survey items contained within the COVID-19 survey during the time frame of late April to early May 2020. The results were tallied on May 27th, 2020. As of April 24th, 2020, there were 138 people imprisoned at Peoria ATC according to IDOCs daily population report; however, this number may include residents who were furloughed and not physically present at the facility. This sample of survey respondents, thus consists of, at minimum, 11.59% of Peorias population. As of June 8, 2020, there were 107 people reported to be at Peoria in IDOCs daily population report.

JHA provided prison administrators with enough survey packets (COVID-19 survey, informed consent notice/instruction sheet, and business reply envelope addressed to JHA) so that every person imprisoned at Peoria had an opportunity to participate in the COVID-19 survey if they chose to do so. Because some people who submitted a survey did not answer all questions within the survey, the count of people who responded to each question is less than the overall sample of 16.

The results of the surveys JHA collected from people imprisoned at Peoria ATC are tabulated on the pages that follow.
